



## ***Health Screening for Anganwadi Workers***



Anganwadi is a type of rural child care centre in India. They were started by the Indian government in 1975 as part of the Integrated Child Development Services program to combat child hunger and malnutrition.

*Anganwadi* means "courtyard shelter" in Hindi. A typical Anganwadi center provides basic health care in a village. It is a part of the Indian public health care system.

Basic health care activities include contraceptive counselling and supply, nutrition education and supplementation, as well as preschool activities. The anganwadi workers are responsible for assisting the doctors in the campaigns for immunization. Create awareness related to reproduction. Providing drugs and medicines kit to the needy.

A Free doctor consultation and dental check-up was conducted for around 50 Anganwadi workers at Rajouri Garden on 3<sup>rd</sup> August`2021.



These workers play an important role and take up immense responsibility on behalf of Government for women and child development in society.
