

*Health screening for visually impaired students*



Blind Welfare Society is a registered non-government voluntary Organization. It was founded to undertake various projects in the field of Education, Employment, Training and Rehabilitation for the people with visual challenges. We have organized a Health Screening Camp at the Blind Welfare Society, Swaroop Nagar, New Delhi for their students who are visually impaired. Free blood diagnostic service was provided.



Around 50 beneficiaries participated in the camp. All of them were young girls. CBC Blood test were conducted. This procedure is used to evaluate your overall health and detect a wide range of disorders, including anaemia, infections and leukaemia. A complete blood count test measures several components and features of blood, including: Red blood cells, which carry oxygen. Our team has also conducted general health counseling session.
